Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 12 August 2025. Following a site visit of the Council's Planning Officer I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works. Whilst the trees hold good amenity value it is considered that the proposed works are appropriate. The Council do not intend to protect this tree further through a Tree Preservation Order (TPO).
