Section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Works to Trees in a Conservation Area

WORKS PROPOSED:

Application to pollard one elm tree located in the north west corner of Nowhere's front garden.

LOCATION:

Thank you for your notification for tree works in a Conservation Area dated 4th December 2025. Following a site visit of the Council's Planning Officer I am writing to confirm that there is **no objection** to the above tree works and that the Council do not intend to protect the Elm tree through a Tree Preservation Order (TPO).
